Information Sheet

The **Lebanon Art and Crafts Association (LACA)** is a cooperative non-profit membership organization, the purpose of which is “to bring Artists and Crafters together for mutual support and encouragement, and to promote appreciation of art and crafts within the area, and to promote the sale of work as a stimulus to the creative interests and talents of the members” (LACA Bylaws). Although most members live in the Upper Valley area, several travel quite some distance to attend meetings and to participate in the organization’s activities.

Meetings

Meetings are generally held at 6:00 pm on the third Wednesday of each month (except November and December. (Please visit our website www.lebanonartandcrafts.org for the location and any meeting changes). At meetings the business of the organization is conducted in a democratic manner, with each member present having a voice and vote in deciding plans and activities. These include: electing officers, determining the community endeavors the Association will support, and arranging and holding shows.

Community Contributions

LACA, as fiscally able, endeavors to annually award contributions to the following: Alden Burt Memorial Award at Lebanon High School; scholarship/awards to students from area high schools who are continuing their education in the field of the arts; and to other art-related projects within the community.

Membership

Artists and crafts people working in any media may become members of LACA upon payment to the treasurer of annual dues (Individual/Patron Membership - \$35.00 or Group Membership - \$35.00 per group member). All work offered by members must be handcrafted and is expected to be of high quality. To be eligible to participate in the annual Christmas Show and Sale, members must: (1) attend at least three regular meetings during the year, (2) work and help with various duties associated with the show and sale, and (3) pay a fee for the Christmas Show plus a percentage of sales (see the Christmas Show application for costs).
